#### General Description of task(s) and objectives to be achieved

Under the general supervision of the Coordinator of FAO sub regional office for North Africa (SNE), the direct supervision of the Officer in charge of FAO Representation in Libya, the technical supervision of the Animal Production and Health Officer (LTO) and in close collaboration with the National Centre for Animal Health (NCAH), the consultant will perform the following tasks:

- 1. Elaborate training material and tools in Arabic on Sheep and Goat Pox diseases and PPR:
  - Situation of the disease in Libya
  - Description of the disease: agent, species, pathophysiology, symptoms, lesions and laboratory diagnosis,
  - Epidemiology of Sheep and Goat Pox and PPR: risk based surveillance, prevention and control...
- 2. Conduct and facilitate training workshops held in Tunisia and Libya (at least in 3 regions, for a total of 150 participants);
- 3. Elaborate work plan of Sheep and Goat Pox field surveillance and PPR disease (number of samples, regions...);
- 4. Supervise field surveillance of Sheep and Goat Pox and PPR in collaboration with the National Centre for Animal Health;
- 5. Facilitate awareness campaigns on Sheep and Goat Pox and PPR in Libya (at least in 3 regions and for at least 200 participants);
- 6. Support elaboration of communication tools on Sheep and Goat Pox and PPR diseases in collaboration with the communication consultant;
- 7. Submit end of mission report

## Qualification:

- Master in Veterinary Medicine;
- Minimum seven (7) year experience in training and management of diseases especially Sheep and Goat Pox and PPR, experience in surveillance and control of Sheep and Goat Pox diseases and PPR;
- Pertinent publications on Sheep and Goat Pox diseases and PPR;
- Good knowledge of animal health system of Libya;
- Language: Good command of Arabic and English in writing and speaking.
